Anderson County Industrial Facilities –

In 1986, the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) was signed into law. Title III of SARA is also known as the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA). Section 311 of the EPCRA requires facilities that store more than the EPCRA threshold quantity of chemicals to submit a Tier II Emergency and Hazardous Chemical Inventory Form to Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, Anderson County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), and the local fire department by March 1st of each year. Anderson County LEPC maintains this information and other emergency planning data for community use.

TN Public Acts Chapter 185 (House Bill 716) grants each LEPC authority to assess and collect fees of \$100 annually from all industrial facilities that submit Tier II Reports. An invoice is enclosed. Please submit \$100 to the Anderson County LEPC along with your Tier II Reports by March 1st.

Your support is appreciated! The fees collected by the Anderson County LEPC support activities vital to the safety of your community. In 2007, these fees were used to purchase and install weather radios in Anderson County nursing homes, provide support to the county during emergency planning exercises, and to provide emergency preparedness information to local citizens.
